

<u>The Center in Addis Ababa</u> provides survivors of sexual violence, mainly survivors of rape, with services such as medical treatment, legal support, psychological treatment, and shelter.



Legal framework: Weak

There is no law in Ethiopia addressing domestic violence, though some general laws mention violence against women:



<u>Constitution (1994)</u>: The Constitution prohibits customs and practices that oppress or cause harm to women.



<u>Criminal Code (2004)</u>: Article 564 prohibits violence against a marriage or other cohabitating partner, and Article 625 criminalizes taking advantage of the dependence of a woman.
